Dear Parents and Guardians,

Hello and welcome to the recital addition of the **To the Pointe Newsletter** for 2017-2018. This newsletter should help you with any question you might have regarding the end of year performance.

The showcase recital "All you need is LOVE" will be performed on Friday May 11th and Saturday May 12th at the E.L. Fox Auditorium located in John F. Ross High School (21 Meyer Drive at Eramosa). There will be three performances of the show this year:

FRIDAY MAY 11th 6:00pm SATURDAY MAY 12th at 11:00am AND 5:00pm

The Pre-Ballet 2, 3, 4, RAD Primary, Pre Jazz, Jazz 1, Jazz 2, Hip Hop 1, and Tap 1 classes will participate in one show. RAD Grade 1, Jazz 3, Hip Hop 2 and 3, Tap 2/3, and Musical Theatre 1 will be performing in 2 shows. All other classes will participate in all three shows. The list of who is performing in which show is included with this package.

We have three nights of dress rehearsals this year: **Tuesday May 8th**, **Wednesday May an 9th**, and **Thursday May 10th at the theatre.** Enclosed is a schedule that will let you know which rehearsal your dancer is to attend. We try to make it most convenient for you, but some of the dancers might need to attend multiple evenings. Please bring your costume to dress rehearsal. Please note that recital hair and make-up are not necessary. **Please arrive 15 minutes before "On Stage" time, we run our rehearsals on time.**

Since our youngest students who only participate in one show perform before intermission might we provide the option for them to join their families to enjoy the 2nd half of the performance. There is an **AFTER-INTERMISSION ticket for Pre Ballet 2, 3, 4, RAD Primary, Pre Jazz, Jazz 1, Jazz 2, Hip Hop 1, and Tap 1 students**. If they do choose to sit with their families they are not able to join the studio for curtain call at the end of the recital. After intermission tickets are restricted to ONLY dancers mentioned above and will be sold at the discounted price of \$7.00.

You will find your ticket order form included with this package. Simply fill it out and return with payment to the studio. The shows do sell out quickly, I would not recommend waiting until the ticket deadline if you require tickets for a specific show. **TICKETS ARE HANDED OUT DURING PHOTO WEEK.**

Costumes

Costumes will be handed out beginning Friday March 23rd. Please make sure to keep them safe and do not allow your children to play with them at home before the recital. Each student is responsible for each part of their costume and is required to bring everything; costume, accessories, tights/socks and shoes to each rehearsal night and show. **Your costume is your responsibility – they are not replaceable.**

Photo Week - Tuesday May 1st- Monday May 7th

Bean Film will be continuing their tenure as our official studio photographers. Photo week will be held during the dancer's regular class time the final week before the show **Tuesday May 1st – Monday May 7th**. Please wear your full costume for photos with proper hair and light makeup. This is also a perfect opportunity for parents to ask any costume questions before the recital. Please note: Monday April 30th is a regular dance classe as their photos are taken the week after – Monday May 7th. We move to the theatre for rehearsals on Tuesday May 8th.

Dress Rehearsals at E.L Fox Auditorium (John Ross High School)

Tuesday May 8th, Wednesday May 9th, and Thursday May 10th we move to the theatre for Dress Rehearsals. Classes do not run at the studio during dress rehearsals. Dancers are to wear their costumes to dress rehearsal, but do not need full hair and makeup. **Do not be alarmed if your dress rehearsal times run back to back, simply wear the first costume for both rehearsals**. Please arrive 15 minutes early, we run our rehearsals on time and cannot wait for late dancers. You don't want to miss your rehearsal time!

All you need is LOVE t-shirts
