### Winter Boots – please remove

With the winter weather on its way, it is important to remind everyone about our boot policy at TGAD. For safety reasons, and to not wreck expensive dance shoes, we ask that everyone removes their winter boots when the entre the reception area. We will have winter carpets to stand on and racks at the front door to place boots. Dancers are permitted to carry their boots to the change room. Do not leave boots on the ground, this causes a tripping hazard for our families. PLEASE LABEL YOUR CHILD'S WINTER BOOTS, so many dancers have the same pair and don't always remember where they left theirs. I hate having to try to track down boots that have gone missing. Often, we can find them, but occasionally they do not get returned to their proper owner. Thank you so much for your understanding and co-operation. Fingers crossed that no boots go missing this year!

### Costume Measurement week 2018-2019

As crazy as this might seem, the faculty and I are deep into recital preparations for our Pre-Ballet 2 and older dancers. We will be measuring the students Monday, November 19<sup>th</sup> to Saturday, November 24<sup>th</sup>. Please make sure that your dancer attends her class this week. If you are going to be away, please contact me so that I can let you know an alternative date. The HUGE costume order is placed early December to make sure that everything arrives in time.

#### **Lost and Found**

If you are missing parts of your dance uniform please check the Lost and Found bin (the green storage box) in the reception area. PLEASE MAKE SURE TO LABEL ALL DANCE CLOTHING...pink ballet slippers and black jazz shoes all look very similar! We also have a huge collection of water bottles, please check the windowsill if your dancer has left theirs at the studio. All unclaimed items will be donated to local charities on our last dance day, Monday December 17<sup>th</sup>.

# **Inclement Weather Policy**

Yes...Winter is coming! Please take a moment to review our inclement weather policy. The decision to run or cancel classes will be made by 2:00pm. I'm hoping that we won't need to use any inclement weather days, but just in case...

- If buses are cancelled, but schools remain open we will be open for dance classes.
- If both buses and schools are cancelled the studio will be closed as well.
- If schools are cancelled due to cold weather check your email for updates.

Special exceptions may apply if a horrendous snow storm starts later in the afternoon, we will keep our eyes on the weather network and will confirm by email to all families.
