Adult Dance Classes

We have four class time options for adult classes during our 2020-2021 dance season: **Mondays 8:30 – 9:30** (Contemporary and Broadway Jazz,), **Tuesdays 8:15 – 9:15** (Ballet), **Wednesdays 8:45 – 9:45** (Tap), and **Thursdays 8:45 – 9:45** (Hip Hop). You can pick and choose which classes to take (or sign up for all of them) – it is completely up to you. Enrollment in the Adult classes is reduced this season to ensure physical distancing. Ballerina Jitters

Nerves are a big part of trying something brand new, and ballet lessons are no exception. I find with the younger students; sometimes it takes 2 or 3 times of coming into the room before they are comfortable. Please do not be discouraged if your dancer does not make it into the room the first week; we will work with you to make sure that your little one is having a positive experience and will try to alleviate any "butterflies" as soon as they arise!

Recitals in 2021

Our studio will be producing two separate recitals for 2021. Our Pre-Ballet 1 dancers (3 years old) will participate in the **"SNOW WHITE"** recital in the studio on Sunday, April 25th, 2021.

All other students will be a part of our BIG show in May 2021. Dress rehearsals are Tuesday, May 11th, Wednesday, May 12th, Thursday, May 13th. Show 1 is **Friday, May 14th at 6:00 pm**, Show 2 and 3 are **Saturday, May 15th at 11:00 am and 5:00 pm**. The list of "Who is in what show" will be emailed at the beginning of January 2021.

- Classes performing in one show: Pre Ballet 2, 3, 4, Primary, Pre Jazz, Jazz 1, 2, Hip Hop 1, Tap 1/2
- Classes performing in two shows: Grade 1, Jazz 3, Hip Hop 2, Musical Theatre 1/2, Tap 3/4
- All other classes will participate in all three shows.

The dates for the recital have been reserved with the UGDSB, and I am hoping to produce our beloved year-end production in May as scheduled. As the pandemic continues to evolve, any recital changes will be communicated with families immediately. Thank you for your understanding.
