

Ballet Bun Help for the Recital

Ballet dancers in Pre Ballet 2 – Advanced 1 require a Ballet bun for the recital and photos. We're here to help!

I will include the key elements that will help you achieve success (it's honestly not that difficult): what you need, bun kits available at the front desk, and YouTube video tutorials.

We can give you a demonstration in person if a faculty member is available.

What you need:

A hairbrush, spray water bottle, elastic, hair pins (not bobby pins), and a hair net.

Bun Kits:

Bun kits are sold at the studio for \$5.00 (cash only). They come with the necessary tools (hair pins for short or long hair, an elastic, a hair net, and four bobby pins for flyaways) and should last you a full season. We have light hair kits as well as dark hair kits, and you can purchase them from the front desk.
